The Chairman called the meeting to order. A quorum was not present but as the Committee was in recess the Chairman opened the meeting to take testimony.

The Chairman recognized Senator Hance to speak on H.B. 769. Dr. John Trautman of the U.S. Public Health Service Hospital spoke for and answered questions on H.B. 769.

The Chairman next explained H.B. 817. Those appearing for the bill were Allen Skidmore, Texas United Community Service and Jack Vick, representing Texas Employment Community. The Chair also recognized J. Ferris Duhon, Texas Employment Commission and Jody Richardson of the Texas Women's Political Caucus who were for the bill but did not testify.

Next the Chairman recognized Senator Mendgen to explain his S.B. 1189. Senator Mendgen explained two amendments which Senator Brooks signed. The amendments were adopted with no objection. Fred Biel, Department of Public Welfare, and Steven Camp, representing Representative Stan Schlueter, testified as a resource person on the bill.

The remaining bills were set for Monday, April 18, at 4:00 p.m. Senator Andujar moved the Committee stand in recess subject to the call of the Chair.
