Members Present: Brooks, Chairman, Andujar, Harris, Jones, Patman


The meeting was called to order. A quorum was not present, but testimony could be heard as the committee had been in recess subject to call of the Chairman.

Discussion was begun on proposed amendments by Senator Andujar to S.B. 392, by Senator Santiesteban. Present to speak for the bill were Senator Santiesteban, and Charles Babb. There to speak against the bill and for the amendments were Senator Andujar and C. Dean Davis. Two amendments were found to be acceptable and were incorporated into the bill without objection.

The Chair then laid out S.B. 1257, which Senator Andujar explained. There was one witness for the bill, Mrs. Margaret Rowland, representing the Board of Nurse Examiners. Upon conclusion of her testimony, further action was postponed.

The meeting then was recessed subject to the call of the Chairman.
