MINUTES OF MEETING OF MAY 12, 1977

Time: 2:00 p.m.

Place: Senate Chamber

Members Present: Brooks, Chairman, Andujar Doggett, Harris, Jones, Lombardino, Patman, Truan

The meeting was called to order. A quorum was present.

The Chair laid out H.B. 360 and recognized the sponsor, Senator Parker. There was one witness for the bill, Joan S. Anderson, PhD representing the Texas Psychological Association. There were two witnesses against the bill:

Ace Pickens, Group Hospital Service, Inc.
Jeff Autrey, Texas Life Insurance Association

Upon conclusion of testimony, further consideration was postponed. Additional testimony will be heard Monday, May 16, 1977.

The Acting Chairman, Senator Harris, laid out S.B. 1317 and recognized the author, Senator Doggett. There was one witness for the bill, Bob Honts, representing Travis County. Upon conclusion of testimony, Senator Doggett moved the bill be reported favorably. The vote was seven ayes and no nays. Local Calendar recommendation was given without objection.

Senator Harris, acting as Chairman in the absence of Senator Brooks, laid out H.B. 2059 and recognized Senator Patman on behalf of the sponsor, Senator Clower. There was one witness for the bill, John J. Sampson, representing himself. Upon conclusion of testimony, Senator Patman moved the bill be reported favorably, the vote was six ayes and one nay.

Senator Doggett, as acting Chairman, then laid out H.B. 2190 and recognized the sponsor, Senator Andujar. Due to absence of a quorum, action was postponed until Monday, May 16, 1977.

The meeting then was recessed subject to the call of the Chairman.
