The meeting was called to order and the clerk called the roll. A quorum was present.

The Chairman laid out H.B. 1880 and explained it. Senator Truan moved the bill be reported favorably. The vote was six ayes and no nays. Uncontested calendar recommendation was made.

The Chair next laid out H.B. 1720 after there was no objection to call the bill from the table. Senator Lombardino, the Senate sponsor spoke for the bill. Larry Niemann, representing the Texas Apartment Association spoke on behalf of the bill. Jim Piper of Clarksville Neighborhood Advisory Board spoke against the bill. Three amendments were adopted without objection. Senator Truan moved postponement of further consideration. There was no objection.

The Committee adopted an amendment by Senator Brooks to H.B. 10.

The Chair laid out H.B. 2105 and recognized Representative Thompson. The following persons testified for the bill:
