Pursuant to public notice posted on March 25, the Senate Committee on Intergovernmental Relations met in a public hearing on Thursday, March 26, 1987 and was called to order by the Chair, Senator John Leedom.

The roll was answered as follows:

S.B. 1024 by Parker

The Chair laid out S.B. 1024 and recognized Senator Parker to present the bill.

Senator Tejada and Senator Zaffirini now present.

No witnesses appeared to testify in favor of or against S.B. 1024.

Senator Sims moved that the Committee adopt and report S.B. 1024, without amendment, favorably to the Senate with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion prevailed by a roll call vote, reflecting:

The Chair laid out S.B. 746 and recognized Senator Jones to present the bill.


The Chair recognized Mr. George M. Wentsch, representing the Property Owners Association (B.L.E.), to testify in favor of the bill.


