The chair called for any witnesses either for or against the bill. There being none public testimony was closed.


Senator Sims moved that S.B. 105 be reported favorably with the recommendation that it do pass and be printed.
7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 4 Absent.


The chair laid out H.B. 81 by Montford, relating to terms of the board of directors and debts of the Ector County Hospital District.
