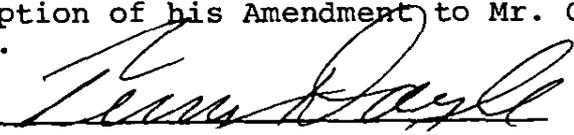

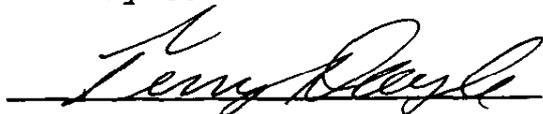

Mr. Cavness moved to rerefer H.B. No. 454 to a sub-committee and asked that it be the same as before.

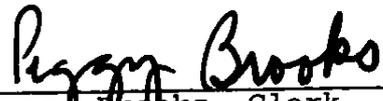
The Chairman directed the Clerk to call the roll and the motion prevailed by the following: (Record Vote No. 48)
