Pursuant to public notice being given on the House Floor, April 2, 1975, the Subcommittee on Legislative Reapportionment met in a formal meeting and was called to order by the Chairman, Rep. Herman Adams.

The roll was answered as follows:

Present: Reyes, Reynolds, Adams (3).

Absent: Coody and Sutton (2).

A quorum was present.

The Chair again laid Lubbock County before the Committee for discussion and recognized Mr. Reynolds to outline his map on Lubbock County.

Mr. Reynolds explained his map and answered questions.

Discussion was held on the several maps concerning Lubbock County presently before the Committee.

The Chair recognized Mr. Pete Laney, a Lubbock County Representative, for his remarks.

The Committee could not reach agreement. The Chair once again declared Lubbock County pending business.

The Chair laid H.B. No. 1813 by Hale before the Committee and asked for discussion on Nueces County.

Discussion was held and because of a lack of time, Nueces County was declared pending business to be discussed at the next meeting.
