Pursuant to public notice being given on the House Floor on Thursday, April 3, the Subcommittee on Legislative Reapportionment met in a formal meeting and was called to order by the Chairman.

Present: Adams, Reynolds and Reyes (3).

Absent: Sutton, Coody (2).

A quorum was present.

The Chair opened the meeting asking for discussion on Nueces County.

Discussion was held.

The Chair recognized Mr. Reyes for a motion.

Mr. Reyes offered an amendment (the Truan map) to subcommittee amendment No. 1 to H.B. No. 1097, as it pertains to Nueces County and moved its adoption.

The Chair called for discussion.

Discussion was held.

Mr. Sutton now present.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the Reyes amendment.

A roll call vote on the Reyes amendment reflected the following:

Ayes: Reynolds, Reyes, Sutton, Adams (4).

Nays: None (0).

Absent: Coody (1).

There being 4 ayes, and no nays and 1 absent, the Reyes amendment to Subcommittee Amendment No. 1 was adopted (see subcommittee amendment no. 5 attached).

Mr. Potter of the Texas Legislative Council was directed to draft the appropriate amendment in compliance with the Truan map previously adopted.


The Chair next placed Lubbock County, pending business, before the Committee for discussion.

Nays: Sutton, Adams (2).


Absent: Coody (1).
