Pursuant to public notice being posted on April 14, 1975 at 5:45 p.m. the Subcommittee on Legislative Reapportionment convened in a formal meeting and was called to order by the Chairman.

The roll was answered as follows:

Present: Reyes, Reynolds, Adams (3).

Absent: Coody, Sutton (2).

A quorum was present.

The Chair laid out the McDonald-Garcia Plan for Hidalgo County and called for discussion.

There being no discussion, the Chair offered an amendment (the McDonald-Garcia map) to subcommittee amendment no. 1 to H.B. 1097, as it pertains to Hidalgo County, and moved its adoption.

The Chair called for discussion of his amendment.

There being no discussion the Chair asked for a roll call vote on his amendment to subcommittee amendment no. 1.

A roll call vote on the Adams amendment reflected the following:

Ayes: Reyes, Reynolds, Adams (3).

Nays: None (0).

There being 3 ayes and no nays, 2 absent, the Adams amendment to subcommittee amendment no. 1 was adopted. (see subcommittee amendment no. 9 attached)

Mr. Potter of the Texas Legislative Council was directed to draft the appropriate amendment in compliance with the McDonald-Garcia Map previously adopted.


The Chair laid out Jefferson County, as pending business, and called for discussion.


Discussion was held.
