

Pursuant to a notice posted in compliance with Rule V, Sec.14, the Committee met on the House Floor at 8:40p.m. on May 17th and was called to order by Chairman Lewis.

The roll was answered as follows:

Chair recognized Rep. Willis to present S.B.1295. Rep. Ribak moved to send the bill back to the House Floor and be placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 7/0: AYE: Edwards, Gilley, Lauhoff, Ribak, Stubbeman, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Chair recognized Rep. Cates to present H.B.1589/S.B.915. The House Bill being tabled, S.B.915 was considered. Rep. Edwards moved to send the bill back to the House Floor and the motion carried 7/0: AYE: Edwards, Gilley, Ribak, Stubbeman, Tejeda, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Chair recognized Rep. Semos to present H.B.1815 (which was tabled) and S.B. 986. Mr. T.A. Vines, Constable, testified in favor of the bill. Rep. Gilley moved to send the bill back to the House Floor and placed on Consent Calendar. The motion carried 7/0: AYE: Edwards, Gilley, Ribak, Stubbeman, Tejeda, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Chair recognized Rep. Semos to present S.B. 1209. Rep. Ribak moved to send the bill back to the House Floor and placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 7/0: AYE: Edwards, Gilley, Ribak, STubbeman, Tejeda, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Chair recognized Rep. Salinas to present H.B. 1061. Rep. Gilley moved the bill be sent back to the House Floor and placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 7/0: AYE: Edwards, Gilley, Ribak, Stubbeman, Tejeda, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Chair recognized Rep. Parker to present H.B. 1550. Mr. Jim White City Manager of Denton testified in favor of the bill. Rep. Chair recognized Rep. Watson to present H.B. 644/S.B. 337. H.B. 644 being tabled, S.B. 337 was then considered. Mr. Eugene Jenson, County Attorney for Anahuac testified in favor of the bill. Rep. Gilley moved the bill be sent back to the House Floor and placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 7/0: AYE: Edwards, Gilley, Ribak, Stubbeman, Tejada, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Chair recognized Rep. Agnich to present H.B.842. Mr. James Fountain, Dallas City Auditor testified in favor of the bill. Rep. Untermeyer offered committee amendment #1 which was adopted without objections. Rep. Untermeyer moved the bill be sent back to the House Floor as amended and placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 9/0: AYE:Edwards, Gilley, Lauhoff, Ribak, Schlueter, Stubbeman, Tejada, Untermeyer & Lewis.

Testifying against the bill were Mr. Jim Chase, Resort Manager; Leonard Roth, Atty.; Anna Campbell, Camp Owner; David Lowell, Salesman; Bill Schauer; Rosemary Red; and Terry Parker, Consultant. Rep. Ribak moved the bill be sent to the subcommittee on Local Government; there being no objections, it was so ordered.

Chair recognized Rep. Florence to present H.B. 1036. Testifying in favor of the bill was Mr. Charles Still, Upshur County Commissioner. Rep. Gilley moved to send the bill back to the House Floor and Rep. Ribak made a substitute motion to send the bill to subcommittee. Rep. Gilley moved to table the Ribak motion which carried 4/3. The motion to send the bill back to the House Floor carried 7/1: AYE: Gilley, Lauhoff, Schlueter, Stubbeman, Tejada, Untermeyer, and Lewis; NO: Ribak.

Chair recognized Rep. Ceverha to present S.B.'s 961, 1231 & 1232 all in conjunction with each other, as they were related. Rep. Hendricks testified in favor of these bills. Rep. Schlueter moved to send the bills back to the House Floor and placed on Consent. The motion carried 8/0 on all three.

Chair recognized Rep. Hudson to present H.B. 470. Rep. Ribak moved the bill be sent back to the House Floor and placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 7/1: AYE: Gilley, Lauhoff, Ribak, Schlueter, Stubbeman, Tejada & Lewis; NO: Untermeyer.

Chair recognized Rep. Green to present S.B.443. Dennis Holder, Houston Fire Fighter testified in favor of the bill. Mr. Joe Perino, Houston Fire Chief testified against the bill. Rep. Gilley offered committee amendment #1 which was adopted without objections. Rep. Ribak moved to send the bill to subcommittee and the motion carried

Ribak moved the bill be sent back to the House Floor and placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried 8/0: AYE: Gilley, Lauhoff, Ribak, Schlueter, Stubbeman, Tejada, Untermeyer, & Lewis.

Hill conceded to Mr. Bob Honts, Travis County Commissioner to close on the bill. Rep. Stubbeman moved the bill be sent to the subcommittee on Urban Affairs and it was so ordered.




