Ayes: Garcia of Bexar, Jackson (2).


Nays: Maloney (1).



H.B.'s 237, 655, 1156, 575, 1146, 813:


The Chair laid out H.B.'s 237, 655, 1156, 575, 1146, 813 for discussion.
