The Chair recognized Mr. G. E. Simmons, Jr., representing the Texas Department of Public Safety, to testify for the bill.


The Chair recognized Mr. Richard Oliver, representing the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation, to testify for the bill.

H.B. 458 was referred to the Subcommittee on Motor Transportation.


The Chair laid out H.B. 448 and recognized its sponsor, Mr. Bird, to introduce the bill.
