

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

May 18, 1979 upon adjournment of the House

Representative Grant's desk, House Floor

Pursuant to a notice filed with the Journal Clerk and read by the Reading Clerk while the House was in session on May 18, 1979, the Judiciary Committee convened in a formal meeting at 6:25 p.m. and was called to order by the Chair, Representative Ben Z. Grant.
