Rep. Henderson's Desk (#3) on the House floor.

Pursuant to House Rule Sec. 3.0846b by announcement filed with the journal clerk and read by the reading clerk on the House floor on Thursday, May 7, 1981, Subcommittee C of the Government Organization Committee met in a formal meeting and was called to order by the Chair, Rep. Don Henderson.

The roll was answered as follows:

Present: Representatives Don Henderson, Arnold Gonzales, Juan Hinojosa, and Chip Staniswalis (4).

Absent: Representative Reby Cary (1).

A quorum was present.

The Chair laid out S.B. 851, by Doggett, relating to the State Board of Plumbing Examiners. The appropriate across-the-board amendments were adopted without objection.

Rep. Gonzales moved that S.B. 851 as amended be favorably reported to the full Committee as a complete substitute with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried with four (4) ayes (Henderson, Gonzales, Hinojosa, and Staniswalis).

The Chair laid out S.B. 109, by Doggett, relating to the Texas Optometry Board. The appropriate across-the-board amendments were adopted without objection.

Rep. Staniswalis moved that S.B. 109 as amended be favorably reported to the full Committee as a complete substitute with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried with four (4) ayes (Henderson, Gonzales, Hinojosa, and Staniswalis).


