Pursuant to an announcement of the House floor, in accordance with the House Rules, the House Redistricting Committee met in a formal meeting and was called to order by the Chair, Representative Delwin Jones, at 2:21PM.

The roll was answered as follows:

A quorum was present.

The Chair laid out House Bill 1 (Plan H714).

Representative Seidlits now present.

The Chair recognized Mr. Jeff Archer of the Texas Legislative Council as a resource witness to answer questions regarding H.B. 1.

The Chair laid out Amendment #1 (H716) by Craddick regarding redistricting of the state and asked Representative Craddick to explain the amendment.

Representative Jones moved adoption of the Craddick amendment.

The motion failed by the following vote:

AYE: Earley, Finnell, Martinez, McCollough, Rodriguez, Russell, Seidlits, Wilson (8).


NAY: Jones, Craddick, Marchant, Rodriguez (4).


PNV: (0).
