The roll was answered as follows:

ABSENT: Blair, Craddick, Finnell, Grusendorf, Marchant, Rodriguez, Wilson (7).

A quorum was present.

H.R. 150

The Chair laid out H.R. 150 for consideration.

Representative Marchant now present.

Rep. Martinez offered an amendment to H.R. 150.

Rep. Martinez moved for the adoption of the amendment.

The motion to adopt the amendment prevailed without objection.

Rep. Martinez offered an amendment to the resolution.

Upon explaining the amendment, Rep. Martinez moved for the adoption of the amendment.

There being no objection, the amendment was adopted.

Rep. Martinez moved that H.R. 150 be reported favorably to the full House as amended with the recommendation that it do pass.


