

On motion of Senator Ellis, the vote refusing to pass Senate bill No. 638, "An act to authorize the county of Travis to issue bonds to build a courthouse and jail," over the veto of his Excellency, the Governor, was reconsidered.

The question then being, "Shall the bill pass, notwithstanding the objections of his Excellency, the Governor," it was passed by the following vote:

YEAS—Senators Allison, Ball, Baker, Burton, Dwyer, Ellis, Erath, Flanagan, Joseph, Ledbetter, Morris, Parker, Russell, Shepard, Stirman, Swift and Westfall—17.

NAYS—Senators Bradley, Camp, Davenport, Friend and Moore—5.

Senator Davenport called up House bill No. 853, "An act to incorporate the 'Waco Greys,' of the city of Waco, McLennan county." Bill read first time.

On motion of Senator Davenport, the rules were suspended, bill read second time and passed to third reading.
