

# PROCLAMATION

## Governor of the State of Texas

To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

WHEREAS, the Forty-first Legislature at its Extraordinary Session, passed House Bill No. 11, being "AN ACT to amend Article 3221 of Chapter 3, of Title 51 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas of 1925 so as to change the name of the Deaf, Dumb and Blind Asylum for Colored Youths to the Deaf, Dumb and Blind Asylum for Colored Youths and Colored Orphans; authorizing the State Board of Control to adopt rules and regulations for the admission, government and discharge of orphan applicants to said institution; making appropriations to care for the support, maintenance and transportation of said orphans for the fiscal years ending August 31, 1929, August 31, 1930, and August 31, 1931; accepting the donation to the State of the Dickson Colored Orphanage property situated near Gilmer, Texas, and authorizing the Board of Control to sell said property; and declaring an emergency"; and

WHEREAS, said item of Seventy-five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars, carried in Section 3 of said Bill, has been vetoed for the reasons set out in the following statement, which has been filed with said Bill in the office of the Secretary of State;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, DAN MOODY, Governor of the State of Texas, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of this State, have vetoed said item for the reasons stated and on file, and do hereby proclaim said action to have been taken.

The item of Seventy-five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars,  
carried in Section 3 of the attached Act, being

"AN ACT to amend Article 3221 of Chapter 3, of Title 51 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas of 1925 so as to change the name of the Deaf, Dumb and Blind Asylum for Colored Youths to the Deaf, Dumb and Blind Asylum for Colored Youths and Colored Orphans; authorizing the State Board of Control to adopt rules and regulations for the admission, government and discharge of orphan applicants to said institution; making appropriations to care for the support, maintenance and transportation of said orphans for the fiscal years ending August 31, 1929, August 31, 1930 and August 31, 1931; accepting the donation to the State of the Dickson Colored Orphanage property situated near Gilmer, Texas, and authorizing the Board of Control to sell said property; and declaring an emergency",

is hereby vetoed.

This sum of money would be available to the Board of Control from the date this Act is filed with the Secretary of State up to and including August 31, 1929, for the support and maintenance of the Deaf, Dumb and Blind Asylum for Colored Youths and Colored Orphans. Whatever funds are needed for this purpose are in my judgment available to the Board from the appropriations now in force. The period of time between the date this Bill will be filed and August 31, 1929, is a matter of only twenty-two days. This fund will not be needed, and, in my judgment, it could not be used, because of the things which must necessarily be done before the negro children in the Dickson Colored Orphanage can be moved to the State institution.
