WHEREAS, THE Forty-first Legislature at its Extraordinary Session passed House Bill No. 3, being "An ACT making appropriation for the support and maintenance of the State government for the two year period beginning September 1, 1929, and ending August 31, 1931, and for other purposes, and prescribing certain regulations and restrictions in respect thereto, and declaring an emergency"; and,

WHEREAS, certain items of said Bill have been vetoed, as set out in the following statement, which has been filed with said Bill in the office of the Secretary of State:


I have vetoed the above listed items because I do not believe that they are necessary for the adequate support and maintenance of the several departments of the State government.

Most of the items vetoed represent increases over the past two year period. I did not feel that these increases were necessary for the adequate support of the government.

GOVERNOR OF TEXAS

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, DAN MOODY, Governor of the State of Texas, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of this State, have vetoed said items in said Bill, and have approved all other items in said Bill, for the reasons stated and on file, and do hereby proclaim said action to have been taken.
