
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 14 of the Texas Constitution, I, William P. Clements, Jr., Governor of Texas, do hereby veto S.B. 1272 because of the following objections:


This bill as originally filed would have made necessary and appropriate changes to the Alcoholic Beverage Code. As finally passed, however, the bill contains provisions which would require the assignment of certain territory to a beer distributor serving private clubs in a dry county when that county elects to permit the public sale of beer. This is an inappropriate change to the Alcoholic Beverage Code.

The Secretary of State shall take notice of this action and notify the Legislature.
