TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 14 of the Texas Constitution, I, William P. Clements, Jr., Governor of Texas, do hereby veto S.B. 269 because of the following objections:

While college loans for prospective and current peace officers is a worthwhile concept, the program outlined in this bill more closely resembles a grant program than a loan program because peace officers will be entitled to cancellation of interest or principal and interest of their loans. Furthermore, prospective peace officers could apply for funds to offset living expenses, without consideration of financial need. This preferential treatment is not in keeping with the spirit of Article 3, Sections 44 and 56 of the Texas Constitution.

The Secretary of State shall take notice of this action and notify the Legislature.


