TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 14 of the Texas Constitution, I, William P. Clements, Jr., Governor of Texas, do hereby veto S.B. 441 because of the following objections:

This bill would make the Advisory Committee on Probation Department Management a permanent committee. It is currently scheduled to expire on September 1, 1989. The principal function of the Advisory Committee, assisting the Texas Adult Probation Commission in establishing guidelines for managing local probation departments, has already been fulfilled. This in combination with the merger of the criminal justice agencies argue against continuation of the Advisory Committee. The new Criminal Justice Board should be free to determine whether such a committee is necessary. If the Board makes that determination, it can request creation of such an advisory committee by executive order.

The Secretary of State shall take notice of this action and notify the Legislature.
