
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 14 of the Texas Constitution, I, William P. Clements, Jr., Governor of Texas, do hereby veto SB 914 because of the following objections:

This bill would require that appraisal district board members also be members of a governing body that appoints members to the appraisal board or be elected officials of a taxing unit. There is no such requirement at present. The change is unnecessary because the current system is generally functioning well, and because that system provides a clear line of accountability in that the governing bodies which vote on appraisal board members are directly accountable to the voters. Furthermore, this bill will likely result in a loss of professional expertise on appraisal boards.


The Secretary of State shall take notice of this action and notify the Legislature.
