BACKGROUND: A navigation district is a special purpose district created by the Legislature

to develop deep water navigation and improve rivers, bays, creeks, streams

and maintain canals and/or water ways of navigation.

Navigation districts also have the authority to acquire, construct and operate

wharfs, docks and other structures necessary for navigation.

DIGEST: HB 2177 would validate and confirm all navigation district acts and

governmental proceedings taken before the effective date of HB 2177, and all navigation district commissioners and officials who took office before

the effective date the bill.

All bonds and other obligations of a navigation district authorized before

the effective date would also be validated and confirmed.

HB 2177 would not confirm or validate the following:

• an act, proceeding, bond or obligation that is the subject of litigation

pending on the effective date;

• a commissioner or official who is the subject of litigation that is pending on the effective date.

The bill would take effect immediately if approved by two-thirds the membership of each house.
