DIGEST: SB 898 would codify, without substantive change, various statutes omitted during prior recodifications, conform codifications enacted by the 74th Legislature to other laws enacted by that Legislature that did not amend the new codes, and make other corrections and changes such as renumbering statutes with duplicate numbers.

If a law enacted by the 75th Legislature affected a provision repealed or redesignated by SB 898, the repealed provision or previous designation would remain in effect, and, in cases of conflict, a law enacted by the current Legislature would control. The bill would take effect September 1, 1997.
