

**SUBJECT:** Sunset review of the office of vehicle fleet management

**BACKGROUND:** The office of vehicle fleet management (OVFM) in the Comptroller's Office administers the state vehicle fleet management plan and the statewide vehicle data reporting system.

**DIGEST:** HB 4414 would subject the office of vehicle fleet management to the Sunset process as though it were a state agency, including a review and analysis of the practical effect of rules adopted by state agencies. Unless continued, the office of vehicle fleet management would expire September 1, 2011. The comptroller would perform the duties of the office of vehicle fleet management as it related to duties of an agency under Sunset review.

The bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2009.
