BACKGROUND: Transportation Code ch. 601, subch. N establishes a financial

responsibility verification program implemented by the Texas Department of Insurance and other agencies for the verification of whether owners of

motor vehicles have established financial responsibility.

It has been suggested that giving justice or municipal courts access to this

program would provide a more efficient process for verifying motor

vehicle liability insurance coverage.

DIGEST: CSHB 196 would authorize a justice or municipal court to access the

financial responsibility verification program for owners of motor vehicles

to verify financial responsibility for the purpose of court proceedings.
