BACKGROUND: Local Government Code sec. 391.0095(e) requires regional planning commissions, councils of governments, or similar regional planning agencies to send to the governor, the state auditor, the comptroller, and the Legislative Budget Board a copy of certain reports relating to the administration of these bodies.

DIGEST: SB 790 would eliminate a requirement by which regional planning commissions, councils of governments, or similar regional planning agencies had to send to the comptroller a copy of certain reports relating to the administration of these bodies.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
