BACKGROUND: Under Education Code sec. 76.026, the pharmacy school at the University

of Texas at Tyler is not eligible to receive funding from the state's formula

funding model for instruction, operations, or infrastructure.

Some have suggested that formula funding should be extended to the

pharmacy school at the University of Texas at Tyler.

DIGEST: CSHB 1794 would repeal Education Code sec. 76.026.

The bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds

record vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take

effect September 1, 2023.

NOTES: According to the Legislative Budget Board, the bill would have an

estimated negative impact of about \$3.3 million to general revenue related

funds through fiscal 2024-25.
