BACKGROUND: Concerns have been raised that when a tax sale results in excess proceeds,

the clerk of the court is required to pay the costs of postage in the process of informing the former owner of the amount of their excess proceeds, their right to claim the excess proceeds, and providing a copy of relevant

statute.

DIGEST: HB 4250 would allow the clerk of the court to deduct the cost of postage

for sending a notice to the former owner of the property from the amount

of the excess proceeds.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2023.
