BACKGROUND: Some have suggested that legislative action is needed to continue the El

Paso County Hospital District health care provider participation program,

which is set to expire December 31, 2023.

DIGEST: SB 849 would extend the El Paso County Hospital District's authority to

operate a health care provider participation program until December 31, 2027. The bill also would allow the district to impose and collect interest and penalties on delinquent mandatory payments in any amount that did

not exceed the maximum amount authorized for other delinquent

payments owed to the district.

The bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take

effect September 1, 2023.
