1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 2 (house committee printing) by adding
2 the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and
3 renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

4 SECTION _____. TEXAS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION. (a)
5 The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission may not spend money
6 appropriated to the agency by Chapter 1281 (H.B. 1), Acts of the
7 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015 (the General
8 Appropriations Act), for use during the state fiscal biennium
9 ending August 31, 2017:

10 (1) for travel outside the state, other than for bona
11 fide and documented law enforcement or investigative activities;
12 or

13 (2) to attend or participate in an event, training,
14 conference, class, or similar activity outside the state.

15 (b) The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission and employees
16 of the commission may not accept payments from or spending
17 authority on behalf of any trade, professional, or industry
18 organization for any purpose or in any form, including a travel
19 subsidy, payment of travel or other expenses for conference
20 presenters, prepaid meals, or lodging.

2 (1) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the
3 bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

4 SECTION _____. HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION:
5 COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION SERVICES. The amount of \$10,546,287
6 is appropriated from the general revenue fund to the Health and
7 Human Services Commission for the state fiscal year ending August
8 31, 2017, for comprehensive rehabilitation services in accordance
9 with Section 117.081, Human Resources Code.

10 (2) Proportionally reduce the general revenue
11 appropriations made in the bill other than the appropriation made
12 in the SECTION added by Item (1) of this amendment by the amounts
13 necessary to achieve a total reduction in general revenue
14 appropriations of \$10,546,287 for the state fiscal year ending
15 August 31, 2017.
