1 Amend S.B. No. 319 (house committee report) by adding the
2 following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and
3 renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

4 SECTION _____. Section 826.042, Health and Safety Code, is
5 amended by adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows:

6 (f) At the time an owner submits for quarantine an animal
7 described by Subsection (b), the veterinarian or local rabies
8 control authority, as applicable, shall:

9 (1) provide written notification to the animal's owner
10 of the date the animal enters quarantine and the date the animal
11 will be released from quarantine;

12 (2) obtain and retain with the animal's records a
13 written statement signed by the animal's owner and a supervisor
14 employed by the veterinarian or local rabies control authority
15 acknowledging that the information required by Subdivision (1) has
16 been provided to the animal's owner; and

17 (3) provide the animal's owner a copy of the signed
18 written statement obtained under Subdivision (2).

19 (g) A veterinarian or local rabies control authority, as
20 applicable, shall fit each animal quarantined under this section
21 with a yellow collar that is distinct in color from the collars of
22 other animals under the care of the veterinarian or local rabies
23 control authority.

24 SECTION _____. Section 826.043, Health and Safety Code, is
25 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to
26 read as follows:

27 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the [The]
28 veterinarian or local rabies control authority may sell the animal
29 and retain the proceeds or keep, grant, or destroy an animal if the

1 owner or custodian does not take possession of the animal before the
2 fourth day following the final day of the quarantine period.

3 (e) A veterinarian or local rabies control authority may not
4 destroy an animal following the final day of the quarantine period
5 unless the veterinarian or local rabies control authority has:

6 (1) notified the animal's owner of the animal's
7 scheduled destruction; and

8 (2) provided the animal's owner a reasonable
9 opportunity to take possession of the animal after providing the
10 notice required by Subdivision (1).

6 Sec. 801.004. APPLICATION OF CHAPTER. This chapter does
7 not apply to:

8 (1) the treatment or care of an animal in any manner by
9 the owner of the animal, an employee of the owner, or a designated
10 caretaker of the animal, unless the ownership, employment, or
11 designation is established with the intent to violate this chapter;

12 (2) a person who performs an act prescribed by the
13 board as an accepted livestock management practice, including:

14 (A) castrating a male animal raised for human
15 consumption;

16 (B) docking or ear-marking an animal raised for
17 human consumption;

18 (C) dehorning cattle;

19 (D) aiding in the nonsurgical birth process of a
20 large animal, as defined by board rule;

21 (E) treating an animal for disease prevention
22 with a nonprescription medicine or vaccine;

23 (F) branding or identifying an animal in any
24 manner;

25 (G) artificially inseminating an animal,
26 including training, inseminating, and compensating for services
27 related to artificial insemination; and

28 (H) shoeing a horse;

29 (3) the performance of a cosmetic or production

1 technique to reduce injury in poultry intended for human
2 consumption;

3 (4) the performance of a duty by a veterinarian's
4 employee if:

5 (A) the duty involves food production animals;

6 (B) the duty does not involve diagnosis,
7 prescription, or surgery;

8 (C) the employee is under the direction and
9 general supervision of the veterinarian; and

10 (D) the veterinarian is responsible for the
11 employee's performance;

12 (5) the performance of an act by a person who is a
13 full-time student of an accredited college of veterinary medicine
14 if the act is performed under the direct supervision of a
15 veterinarian;

16 (6) an animal shelter employee who performs euthanasia
17 in the course and scope of the person's employment if the person has
18 successfully completed training in accordance with Chapter 829,
19 Health and Safety Code;

20 (7) a person who is engaged in a recognized
21 state-federal cooperative disease eradication or control program
22 or an external parasite control program while the person is
23 performing official duties required by the program;

24 (8) a person who, without expectation of compensation,
25 provides emergency care in an emergency or disaster; ~~or~~

26 (9) a consultation given to a veterinarian in this
27 state by a person who:

28 (A) resides in another state; and

29 (B) is lawfully qualified to practice veterinary
30 medicine under the laws of that state; or

31 (10) a licensed health care professional who, without

1 expectation of compensation and under the direct supervision of a
2 veterinarian, provides treatment or care to an animal owned by or in
3 the possession, control, or custody of an entity accredited by the
4 Association of Zoos and Aquariums.
