DIGEST

Throughout the 1800s, the cattle industry of the Southwest flourished, and bronco riding and roping contests at community celebrations gained popularity as competitions. The informal bronco riding and roping contests were the forerunner to organized competitions that awarded prize money to the top competitors.
