DIGEST

Currently, counties must be paid the fully itemized cost of a street project anywhere not on the county road system. H.B. 3185 increases the maximum cost of a construction project which relates to the assistance that a commissioners court of a county is authorized to provide to another governmental entity.

PURPOSE

As proposed, H.B. 3185 increases the maximum cost of a construction project which relates to the assistance a commissioners court of a county is authorized to provide to another governmental entity.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Amends Section 251.015, Transportation Code, to authorize the commissioners court of a county to use certain resources if the cost of a project does not exceed \$15,000, rather than \$3,000.

SECTION 2. Emergency clause.
Effective date: upon passage.
