## **DIGEST**

Currently, Texas law requires hospitals and nursing homes to display a sign at each entrance giving notice in both English and Spanish that it is unlawful to carry a handgun on the premises. This bill would exempt hospitals and nursing homes from including the number "51" on the sign.

#### **PURPOSE**

As proposed, S.B. 131 exempts hospitals and nursing homes from displaying a sign in each entrance with the number "51" on its face.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

#### SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Amends Section 411.2024(b), Government Code, to require hospitals or nursing homes to prominently display a sign in each entrance to the hospital or nursing home with the number "51" on its face.

SECTION 2. Emergency clause. Effective date: upon passage.
