#### **DIGEST**

Currently, the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission has authority to approve the issuance of certain bonds. S.B.1612 would revise the authority of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission over the issuance of district bonds.

## **PURPOSE**

As proposed, S.B. 1612 revises the authority of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission over the issuance of district bonds.

# **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 49.181(h), Water Code, to provide that this section does not apply to a special purpose water district (district) if the district is located entirely in a county that borders Mexico and provides the domestic water supply and sewer service for three or more municipalities and more than 5,000 people.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. Emergency clause.
