## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners has the authority to issue only one license to the owner of a chiropractic facility regardless of the number of chiropractic facilities owned by the owner. As proposed, S.B. 145 allows the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners to issue and collect a fee for each facility owned by the owner.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 201.312(b), Occupation Code, to require rules adopted under this section to provide for the issuance of one facility license to an owner of a chiropractic facility for each, rather than without regard to the number of, chiropractic facility, rather than facilities, owned by the owner.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. Makes application of this Act prospective.
