### **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, there are some concerns, as result of several cases brought before various courts, regarding the application fee for a disabled parking placard. As proposed, S.B. 32 eliminates the application fee for a disabled parking placard and amends related provisions.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 681.003(b), Transportation Code, to delete existing text pertaining to a certain fee. Makes nonsubstantive changes.

SECTION 2. Amends Section 681.005, Transportation Code, as follows:

Sec. 681.005. New heading: DUTY OF COUNTY ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR. Requires each county assessor-collector to send a copy of each application for a disabled parking placard to the Texas Department of Transportation. Deletes existing text pertaining to fees and copies of applications.

SECTION 3. Effective date: September 1, 2001.  
Makes application of this Act prospective.
