## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, an order of protective custody is necessary in order to transfer a person who has been admitted to a county mental health facility under emergency detention from that facility to a facility of the single portal authority or an appropriate inpatient mental health facility. C.S.S.B. 432 sets forth the manner in which a person who has been admitted to a county mental health facility for court ordered mental health services may be transferred to an appropriate mental health facility.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Chapter 574A, Health and Safety Code, by adding Section 574.0025, as follows:

Sec. 574.0025. TRANSPORTATION AFTER FILING APPLICATION FOR CERTAIN PERSONS. Authorizes a county mental health facility that has completed a preliminary examination of a person for whom an application for court-ordered mental health services is filed to transport the person to certain facilities. Provides that the requirements prescribed by Section 574.045 for transporting a patient apply to a person transported under this section.

SECTION 2. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2001.

# SUMMARY OF COMMITTEE CHANGES

Differs from the original by replacing the proposed amendment to Chapter 573C, Health and Safety Code, with a proposed amendment to Chapter 574A, Health and Safety Code.

Removes proposed amendments to Sections 573.022 and 573.025(a), Health and Safety Code.

Redesignates proposed SECTION 4 as SECTION 2.
