### **AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT**

Currently, the salaries of the members of the juvenile board of Parker County are limited to \$6,000 a year.

H.B. 3993 requires that the commissioners court of Parker County pay the juvenile board members an annual salary of not less than, rather than not more than, \$6,000, payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund or from other available funds in Parker County.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 152.1901(c), Human Resources Code, to require the commissioners court of Parker County to pay the juvenile board members an annual salary of not less than \$6,000, rather than not more than that amount, payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund or any other available fund of Parker County.

SECTION 2. Effective date: October 1, 2007.
